
MySQL NDB Cluster 26.7 Release Notes

Abstract

This document contains release notes for the changes in each release of MySQL NDB Cluster that uses version 26.7 of the [NDB \(NDBCLUSTER\)](#) storage engine.

Each NDB Cluster 26.7 release is based on a mainline MySQL Server release and a particular version of the [NDB](#) storage engine, as shown in the version string returned by executing `SELECT VERSION()` in the `mysql` client, or by executing the `ndb_mgm` client `SHOW` or `STATUS` command; for more information, see [MySQL NDB Cluster 26.7](#).
