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Changes in MySQL Enterprise Backup 26.7.0 (2026-07-28)

MySQL Enterprise Backup 26.7.0 is the latest innovation Release for MySQL Enterprise Backup. It supports MySQL Server 26.7.0.

Bugs Fixed

- Incremental backup could stop unexpectedly, or restore a corrupted binlog, if the source binlog was `modulo (16M + range of (0 - 512k))` in size. (Bug #39423995)
- During backup of encrypted InnoDB tablespaces, MySQL Enterprise Backup could wait indefinitely during the final rescan. (Bug #38329588)

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
